

# **COVID-19 PANDEMIC: ALERT LEVEL PROTOCOLS**

Suggested Protocols for reopening Tauranga Bridge Club premises which will obviously need to be checked against the recommendations that NZ Bridge bring out.

#### Level 4 & Level 3

• Clubrooms Closed

#### Level 2

Clubrooms may possibly be open with strict rules and protocols in force.

- Members 70 years and over are NOT permitted to enter the clubrooms
- Members who are unwell in any way or answer yes to any of the following questions are NOT permitted to enter the clubrooms.

Have you or anyone in your household been feeling unwell with cold/flu like symptoms such as fever, sough, sore throat or difficulty breathing?

Been in contact with anyone who has returned from overseas within the last 14 days?

Been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or may have Covid-19?

Has been instructed to self isolate for any reason by the Department of Health?

### SIGNAGE ON BOTH DOORS ASKING THESE QUESTIONS AND ADVISING NOT TO ENTER

- Delegated person to open clubrooms must open all doors and leave open with doorstops so that members do not touch any door handles. External doors to be closed once the session is in progress.
- Tables to be placed at internal entrance to Clubrooms with hand sanitisers placed on them which members **must** use on entering Clubrooms.
- A visitor's register will be located on the front table with the hand sanitisers and must be completed by all people who enter the Clubrooms and are not playing bridge so that a track can be kept of all people in the building at any given time. Norm already has this in place.
- Members to bring their own pens (named if possible) and keep for their own use only.
- Sanitisers to be placed on each table and to be used by members each time there is a movement between tables.
- Tables to be placed 2 metres apart with a limit of 12 tables per session this will need to be checked as to what the rules are and how many people are allowed to congregate.

- Once cards are dealt they are to be placed on a shelf in the office and not to be touched or used again for a period of seven (7) days, OR
- Sessions only to be for those who bring their own tablets and play social/organised bridge on BBO – this option would allow tables and chairs to be separated and would comply for social distancing rules.
- Tissues will be located by the water cooler and in the toilet cubicles which are to be used when getting a drink or opening the toilet down and then disposed of
- There is to be no afternoon tea for the afternoon sessions and members wishing to have a tea
  or coffee MUST make it themselves and rinse their own cups/utensils and place in dishwasher
  so that they are washed and sterilised.
- All members have an obligation to be socially responsible as per current government directives to avoid putting any other members at risk.

## Level 1

All points as per Level 2 with the exception of bullet point 1 whereby 70 years and older are permitted to return.
