(2) Please don't offer advice unless asked for.
 New players have enough on their minds without unasked for comments making them feel inadequate.
 (3) If you do want to point out an error by your

partner, save it until later, away from the table. It saves embarrassment all round.

(4) Be gracious. Don't gloat over a good board.
(5) When the bridgemate is given to East to confirm the result remember that others at the table might also like to look at the data so place it in the middle of the table.

(6) After the hand has been played, do not sit discussing the hand, remember others can hear you and respect that members may still be

playing so keep the noise level down.
(7) Call the Director every time a ruling is required, don't make your own decisions because you think you know the ruling. We have a Director to direct - let them do their job.
